

Dolder Sports winter safety concept

Here are the most important points from the safety concept:

- **People aged 12 and over must wear a mask in all indoor areas. Masks are not required on the ice-skating rink.**
- **The changing rooms are open.**
- **Anyone with illness symptoms must not enter the facilities.**
- **Everyone must comply with the recommendations of the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH).**
- **The COVID-19 regulations for restaurants apply in the restaurant area.**
- **A COVID-19 certificate is required to attend the ice discos.**
- **Organisers of training sessions and events must have an appropriate safety concept.**

We kindly ask that you carefully read through the safety concept before visiting or working in the Dolder Sports facilities, and that you observe the general rules of behaviour and hygiene rules laid out by the Federal Office of Public Health during your stay.

Federal Council extends COVID certificate requirement 08.09.2021

From 13 September, a COVID certificate will be required in the following situations (from the age of 16):

Indoor hospitality venues

- Restaurants and bars
- Clubs and discos

Cultural, sporting and leisure activities indoors

- Museums and libraries
- Leisure facilities
- Zoos
- Casinos
- Fitness centres and sports facilities
- Training sessions*
- Indoor pools and water parks
- Music and theatre rehearsals*

***Exceptions:** Rehearsals and training sessions in fixed groups (max. 30 people), religious services, political events and self-help groups (max. 50 people).

The COVID certificate is available to anyone who is either vaccinated, recovered from COVID or who has tested negative. The certificate can be presented using the app or on paper.

Indoor events*

- Theatre and cinema
- Concerts
- Sporting events
- Private events outside the home (e.g. weddings)

Large-scale outdoor events

- Events attended by over 1000 people

Workplace: Employers may - under certain circumstances and after consultation with employees - incorporate the certificate into their protection plans.

Universities: The cantons and universities may decide on a certificate requirement.

This list is by way of example and not exhaustive. Refer to the COVID-19 Special Situation Ordinance for specific details.

Rules of behaviour

Car park

- If possible, please use the Parkingpay app (parkingpay.ch) for cashless payment of your parking fees.
- Please maintain a distance of at least 1.5 metres from other guests at the parking ticket machines.

Main entrance

Entrance and exit area, public and private area

- Masks must be worn by people aged 12 and over.
- Please maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other guests.
- Observe the arrows.
- Disinfect your hands when entering the facilities.

Entrance and exit area, clubs

- Masks must be worn by people aged 12 and over.
- Disinfect your hands before entering the facilities.

Ticket office

- Use cashless payment methods if possible.

Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink)

Changing rooms

- Masks must be worn by people aged 12 and over.
- Please observe the signs on the rules of behaviour for the changing rooms
- Observe the arrows.
- Please maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other guests.

WCs and showers

- Masks must be worn by people aged 12 and over in the WCs.
- Please maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other guests when showering (only use every second shower).

Stands

- No restrictions.

Outdoor area

- No restrictions.

On the ice-skating rink

- No restrictions.

Dolder Sports restaurants

Capacity

- No restrictions.

Ticket office

- Masks must be worn by people aged 12 and over.
- Please maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other guests.
- Use cashless payment methods if possible.

Self-service

- Masks must be worn by people aged 12 and over.
- Observe the arrows.
- Only touch the things you will buy.
- Please maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other guests.

Guest area

- A COVID-19 certificate is required to eat in the indoor area.
- No restrictions for eating in the outdoor area.

Special conditions of use for clubs and trainers*

Training

To train at Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink), the organisers of training sessions must obtain permission from Dolder Kunsteisbahn. Those responsible must also have a safety concept for training that complies with government guidelines and those of the canton of Zurich. The safety concept must be provided to Dolder Kunsteisbahn staff when requested by Dolder Kunsteisbahn.

A well-ventilated training room (46.5 m²) for off-ice training sessions is available in the public changing room area. The training room can only be accessed using a code. We recommend calculating 4 m² per person in the organiser's safety concept.

Access to Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink)

To make public access easier and safer, clubs have a separate club and player entrance that can be accessed during training times using a code. Club members are not permitted to use the public entrance.

Club and trainer information requirements

Those responsible, represented by the person who obtains authorisations, must ensure that all

- trainers
- sportspeople
- parents (for youth training)

have received detailed information about the sports facility's and the club's safety concept, are aware of current safety measures and strictly comply with them.

Dolder Sports

Events

Events, including friendly games and competitions, must have their own safety concept. The event's safety concept must comply with government guidelines. This safety concept must be submitted at least seven days in advance to info@doldersports.com

Breaches

In the event of any breaches of the safety measures laid out in the concepts, permission to use the sports facility can be immediately revoked.

Special conditions of use for schools

Use of Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink)

In order to use Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink), a school must have a booking confirmation from Dolder Kunsteisbahn. The school must also have a safety concept for schools that complies with government guidelines. The safety concept must be provided when requested by Dolder Kunsteisbahn.

School information requirements

The school, represented by teachers and/or supervisors, must inform students in detail about the facility's and the school's safety concept and ensure that students strictly comply with them.

Responsibilities and implementation

Dolder Sports

The operator is responsible for the successful implementation of this safety concept. The operator is authorised to issue instructions to visitors to the facilities and will actively monitor the situation to ensure compliance with the rules. If the behaviour of one or more visitors poses a health risk, the operator has the right to eject the persons in question from the facilities.

Persons using the facilities

Persons using the facilities are personally responsible for ensuring that they comply with the general safety and hygiene rules laid out by the Federal Office of Public Health as well as the rules of behaviour from the safety concept for the Dolder Sports facilities.
