### BAVARIAN CURLING TEAM EVENT

Bavarian curling under the open sky at the Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink) promises fun for young and old. You'll experience memorable moments on Europe's largest open-air ice-skating rink, high up on the Zürichberg.

Bavarian curling combines a centuries-old tradition with a modern and attractive game that's fun for all ages. Similar to curling, Bavarian curling is easy to learn. After a brief introduction to the rules and the proper technique, a friendly team competition according to traditional Bavarian curling rules can commence.

The price includes rink rental, instruction by an experienced instructor, all required equipment and admission to the Dolder Kunsteisbahn (open-air ice-skating rink).

In dry weather, Bavarian curling or Lättlischiesen are played right on the rink. If it rains, the activity is shifted to the concrete rink adjacent to the ice rink.

## BAVARIAN CURLING INSTRUCTIONS

EXPLANATION	Two teams face off on the rink (a group of 10 people would form two teams of 5). Two target fields are marked out on the rink, with the shooting positions are also marked out within them. The movable, circular, black target is called a "Daube" and a round is called a "Kehre". The objective is to place the ice stock as close to the Daube as possible.
GAME	The starting team continues playing until it has successfully placed an ice stock in the target field. Then it's the other team's turn. They keep playing until they have played a better-placed ice stock than the other team. The process continues in this manner. Sometimes the starting team is not able to place all of its ice stocks in the target field. In this case, the opposing team has the chance to place all the remaining ice stocks in the target field and gain points.
SCORING	Only the team that is closer to the Daube can win points. Ice stocks that are not in the target field are not scored and garner no points. Scores are only awarded to the ice stocks that are closer to the Daube than the nearest ice stock of the opposing team. In case of uncertainty, a measurement is undertaken. Every ice stock that meets the requirements scores a point and is counted for each round. The winner is the team that scores the most points. If there are multiple teams, a tournament with a semi-final and final can be held. The game is explained and supervised by the instructors. They also keep score and determine the winner.

## LÄTTLSCHIESSEN

**BRIEF EXPLANATIONS** Lättlschiessen is particularly ideal for larger groups. Players are divided into teams of six to eight players and the game is played on up to three rinks. The objective is to score as many points as possible with the ice stock. The score is determined by the number on the plate hanging from the bar that was hit by the stock.

**THE GAME** Is played on the ice in one direction. Each team plays 3–4 rounds and attempts to score as many points as possible. The best teams square off in the semi-finals and finals.

**SCORING** The number of points per throw is determined by the point plate on the bar that spins when it is hit by the ice stock handle. The number plates are movable and rotate around the bar when struck, which indicates a successful throw. Scores of 1 to 10 points are possible on each throw.

The game is explained and supervised by our instructors. They also keep score and determine the winning team.

Since the number of points scored is visible from a distance, spectators are part of the game. Cheering allowed!
